Count on and back to 100 from any given number.

Read and write numbers from 0-20 in words and numerals.

Understand these symbols: addition (+), subtraction (-), equals (=).

Use 'more than', 'less than', 'most', 'least' when talking about numbers.

Begin to learn number bonds to 20.

Add and subtract 1-digit and 2-digit numbers to 20.

Use objects to help you work out the missing number in addition and subtraction sentences.

With help, find answers to multiplication and division problems.

Find and name fractions of shapes and numbers for $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$.

Compare and describe measurement of length, mass, capacity and time.

Tell your teacher the best unit of measurement for a task. Begin to make a record of your

Recognise and use pounds and pence.

Remember days of the week, months and years.

Order daily events using common terms.

Read the time to the hour and half hour.

Name some 2D and 3D shapes. Sort them, giving your reasons.

Use the terms: 'right', 'left', 'forwards' and 'backwards'.

Be able to show whole, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ turns.
