They will make close observations into Andy Warhols designs and find suitable colours and designs to fit the brief of the artwork required. They will choose suitable figures to sketch as a plan and then aim to recreate this in their final piece. Reason In art we will be studying the famous artist Andy Warhol throughout the school. As well as learning his techniques, children will be prepared for the next topics within the current year as their knowledge of colour, painting and sketching will grow. It is important to study a variety of artists and Warhols's work was pivotal in the world of art and allowed a larger acceptance of modern art as we know it.
